

# **ATTENTION ALL INMATES**

The sections of the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act dealing with 'changing your name' have been amended.

An inmate wishing to change his/her name must get approval from the Commissioner of Corrective Services NSW (CSNSW) to submit an application.

It is an offence under the Act to apply to the Registrar of Births, Deaths and Marriages without first obtaining the written approval of the Commissioner CSNSW.

If you wish to change your name, ask the Wing/Unit Officer to give you an application. If you need help filling out the application, ask an officer for help. Once you have filled the application out, give it back to the Wing/Unit Officer.

The Commissioner CSNSW will advise you, in writing, of the result of your application.
