ARE YOU THINKING OF CHANGING YOUR NAME?

The sections of the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act dealing with 'changing your name' have been amended.

If you are being supervised on the following Orders you **MUST** get approval from the Commissioner of Corrective Services NSW (CSNSW) before you submit an application to Births Deaths and Marriages:

- o Parole Orders
- o Extended Supervision Orders
- Interim Extended Supervision Orders
- Intensive Correction Order
- Home Detention
- o Community Supervision Order from the Drug Court

It is an offence under the Act to apply to the Registrar of Births, Deaths and Marriages without first obtaining the written approval of the Commissioner CSNSW.
