# **Volunteer Mentoring Service – VMS**

The Volunteer Mentoring Service (VMS) offers an external leave pathway to assist an inmate's reintegration through a pro-social support model. VMS will provide:

- Pre-release support to improve eligibility for parole by completing the pre-release external leave requirement
- Post release support to address transitional needs and establish community support networks
- The service provider will work in collaboration with CSNSW to link support directly to the inmate's case plan to reduce the risk of reoffending
- Support can be provided up to 12 months before earliest release date from custody.

## What are the eligibility criteria?

- ✓ Limited / no family or community support to sponsor external leave
- ✓ Has served a longer sentence (5+ years) or has cycled in and out of custody
- ✓ Has appropriate classification for pre-release external leave (C3 male; Cat 1 female)
- ✓ In the community on parole or an Extended Supervision Order

# Are there exclusionary criteria?

No. There are no exclusions for risk (LSI-R) level, complexity of need or offence type.

#### How can I refer an inmate to this service?

- ✓ Speak to the Functional Manager\* at the Correctional Centre
- ✓ Complete the VMS referral form (available on the <u>PACE Intranet page</u>)
- ✓ Contact the VMS Coordinator.
- \* The Functional Manager will be the key referrer. However if you have identified an inmate who might be suited to VMS, you can speak to the Functional Manager to progress a referral.

#### Who is the VMS Coordinator?

The VMS Coordinator is the person who processes and manages referrals and can also assist with any questions.
