Safety measures

- From 23 November, 2 visitors (including children, this means two adults or one child and one adult) per inmate
- From December 10, a visit may consist of 2 adults or 1 adult and up to 3 children
- A fist bump or elbow bump at the beginning and end of the visit is allowed but inmates and visitors must maintain physical distance at all other times
- Inmate and visitors must wear masks
- Temperature check and screening criteria will apply to visitors
- Maximum 30 minute visit

- From 15 February 2021, a visit may consist of up to three adults or two adults and up to three children under the age of 18.
- Inmate and visitors must wear masks
- Temperature check and screening criteria will apply to visitors
- Visits may run for up to 50 minutes

- 4 visitors (plus children) per inmate
- Normal contact policies apply
- Screening criteria will apply to visitors
- Visits may run for up to an hour
- Physical distance must be maintained. A brief hug at the beginning and end of a visit is allowed.
