
CSEC Review Flow Chart

- Bimonthly CSEC meetings and cut- off dates published on <u>CSEC website</u>.
- Cut-off date one month before next meeting
- Reach out and submit early to determine process and allow for initial consultation, review and feedback: <u>ethics.committee.csnsw@justice.nsw.gov.au</u>
- All research-based activities within CSNSW jurisdiction require prior ethics approval. Out-of-session approval is usually limited to low risk projects. Research requiring direct contact to CSNSW staff, offenders in custody or community to conduct interviews, surveys, focus groups or medical examinations are more than low risk and considered at a CSEC meeting.
- Review criteria: Quality, ethical implications and impact of proposed research on CSNSW operations.
- Approval time depends on project type and review outcomes (expect at least 3-4 months).
- Commissioner's final approval time is beyond CSEC control and depends on competing CSNSW priorities.
