Apparent unnatural death	The death of a person who is in corrective services custody (which includes deaths that occur within prisons, during transfer to or from prison, within a medical facility following transfer from prison, or in the custody of corrective services outside a custodial facility):
	 whose death is caused or contributed to by traumatic injuries sustained, or by lack of proper care, while in such custody
	 who dies or is fatally injured in the process of prison officers attempting to detain that person
	 who dies or is fatally injured in the process of that person escaping or attempting to escape from prison custody
	 where there is sufficient evidence to suggest, subject to a Coroner's finding, that the most likely cause of death is homicide, suicide, an accidental cause of a drug overdose.
