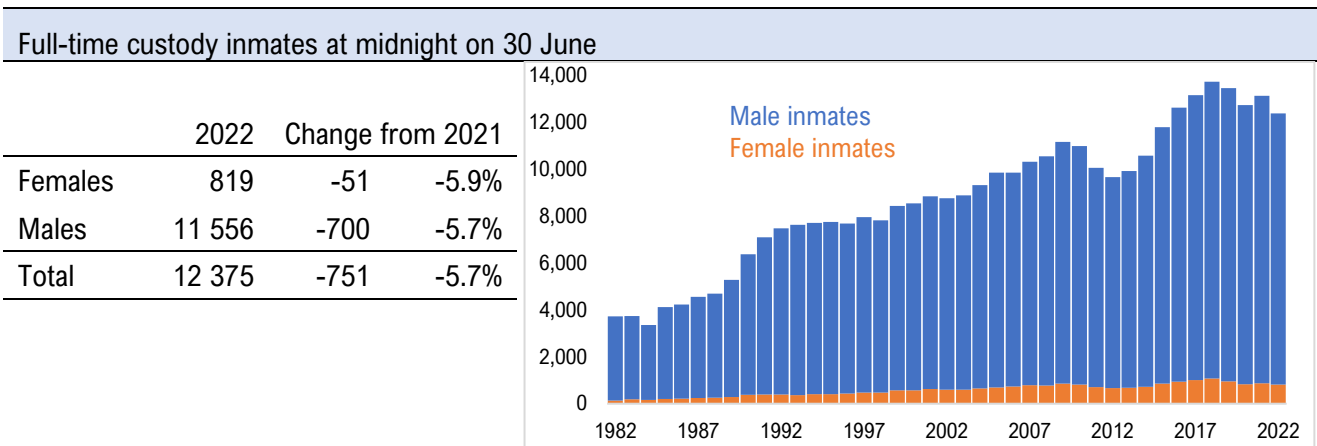

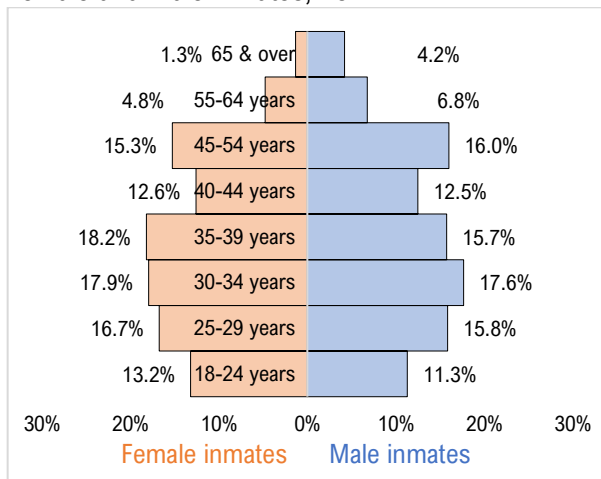

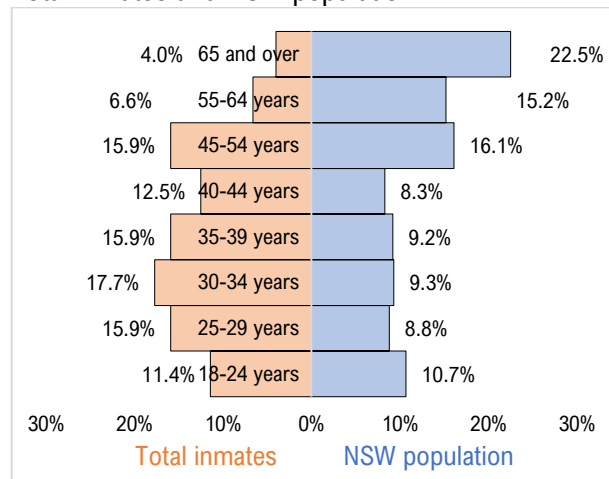
Age of inmates, 2022

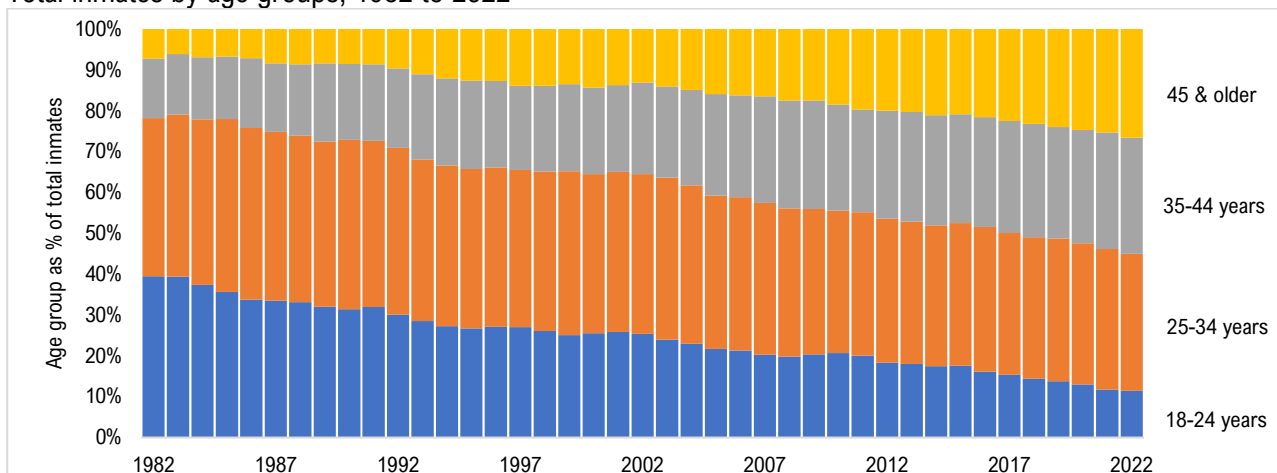

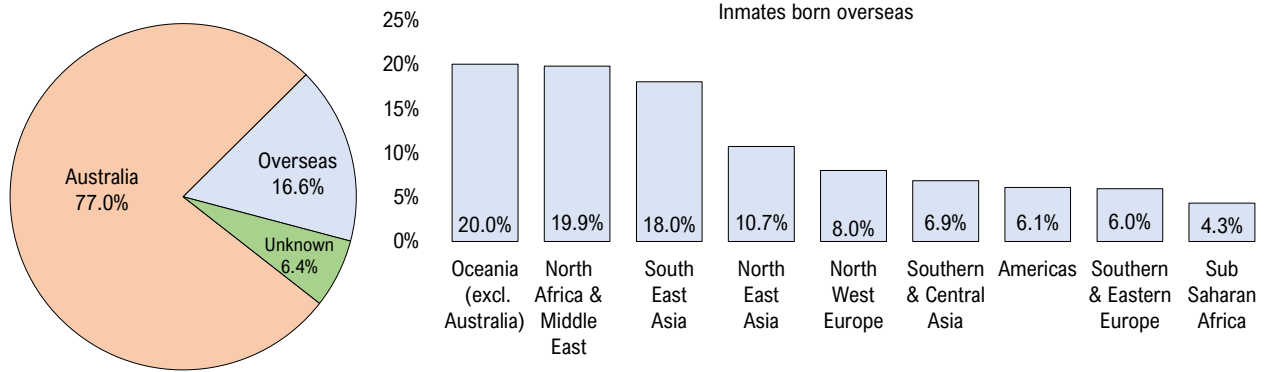
Total inmates and NSW population



Total inmates by age groups, 1982 to 2022



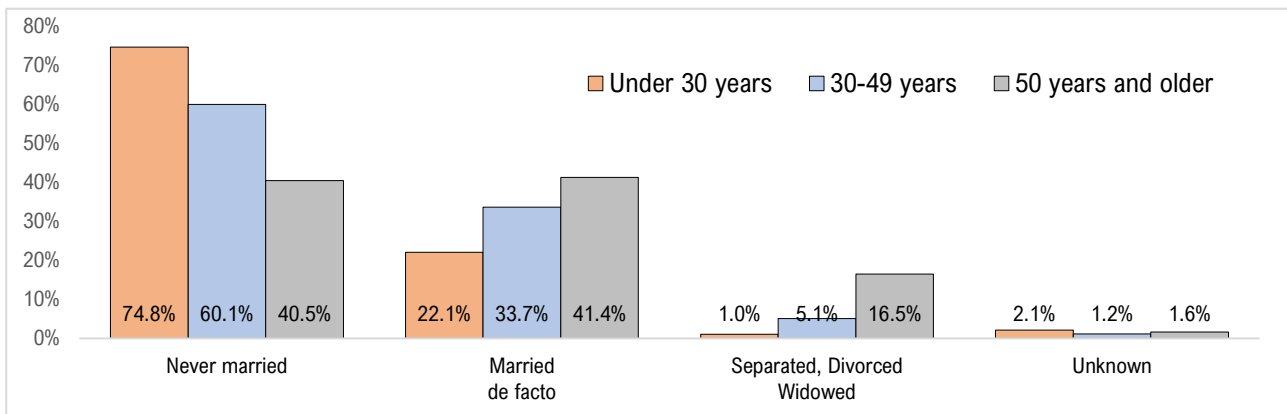
Birthplace of inmates, 2022



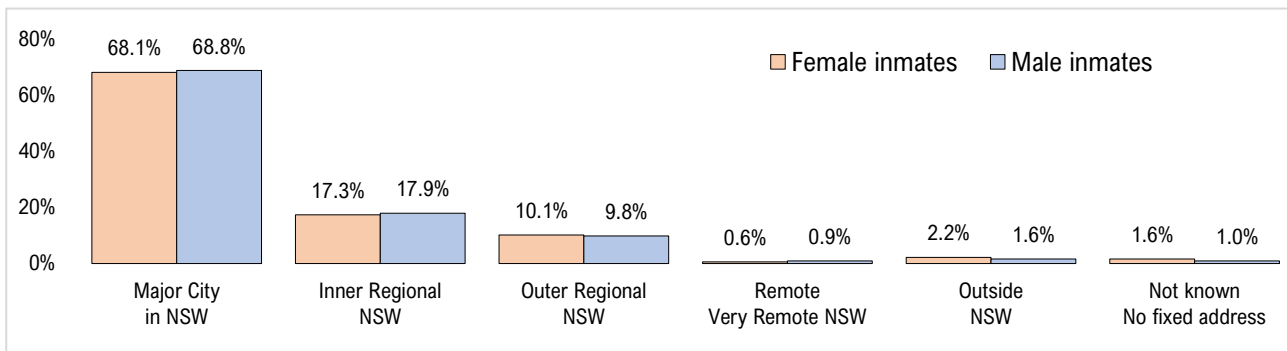

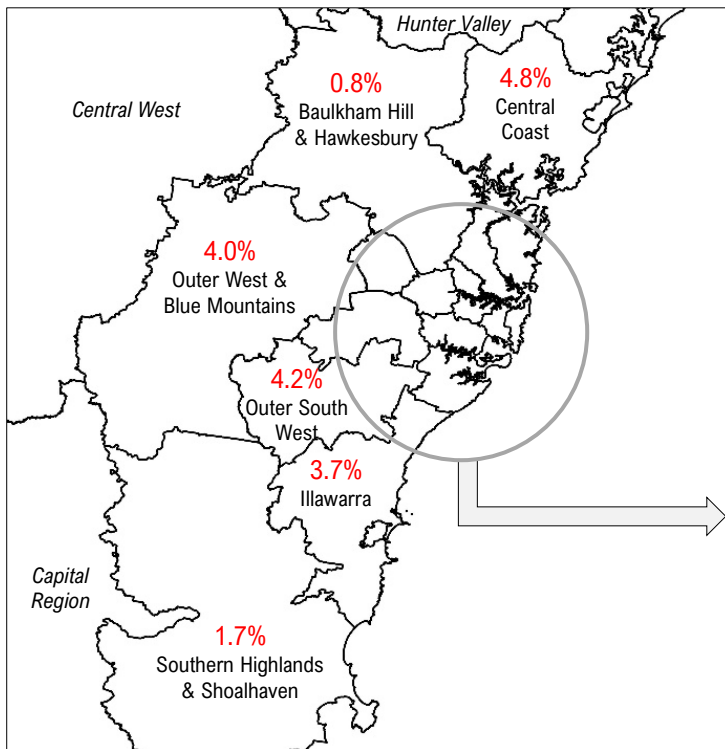
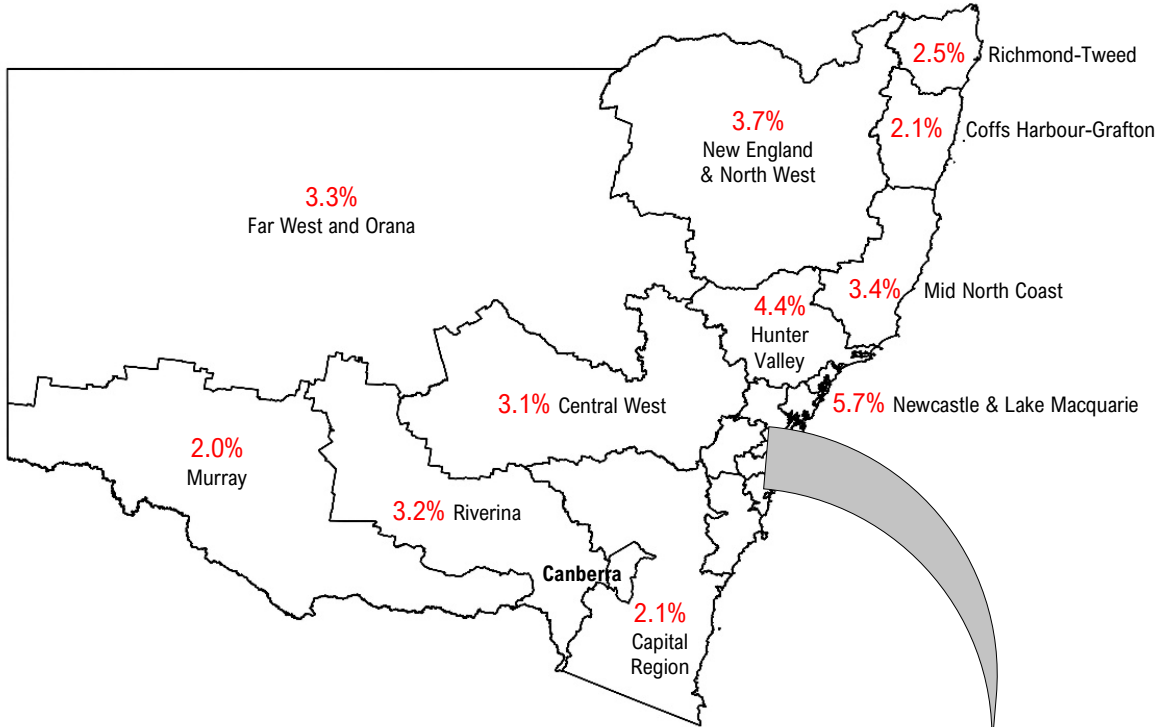
Marital status at reception for inmates, 2022



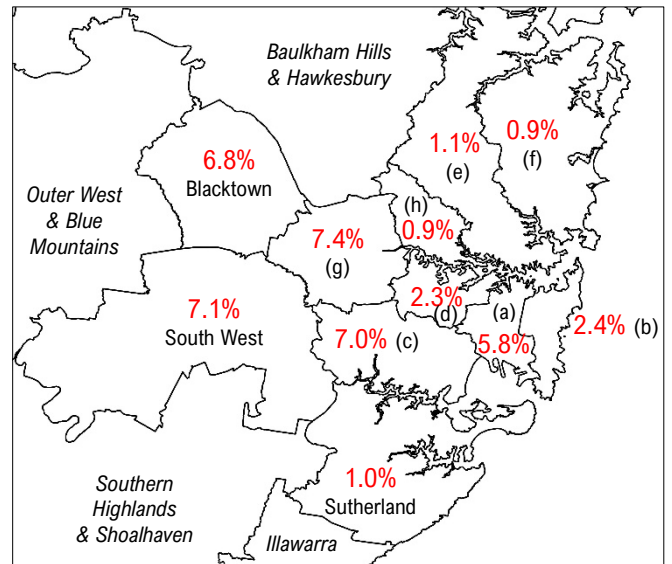
Last known address (ABS remoteness categories) of inmates, 2022



Last known address of inmates by ABS geography (Statistical Area Level 4), 2022



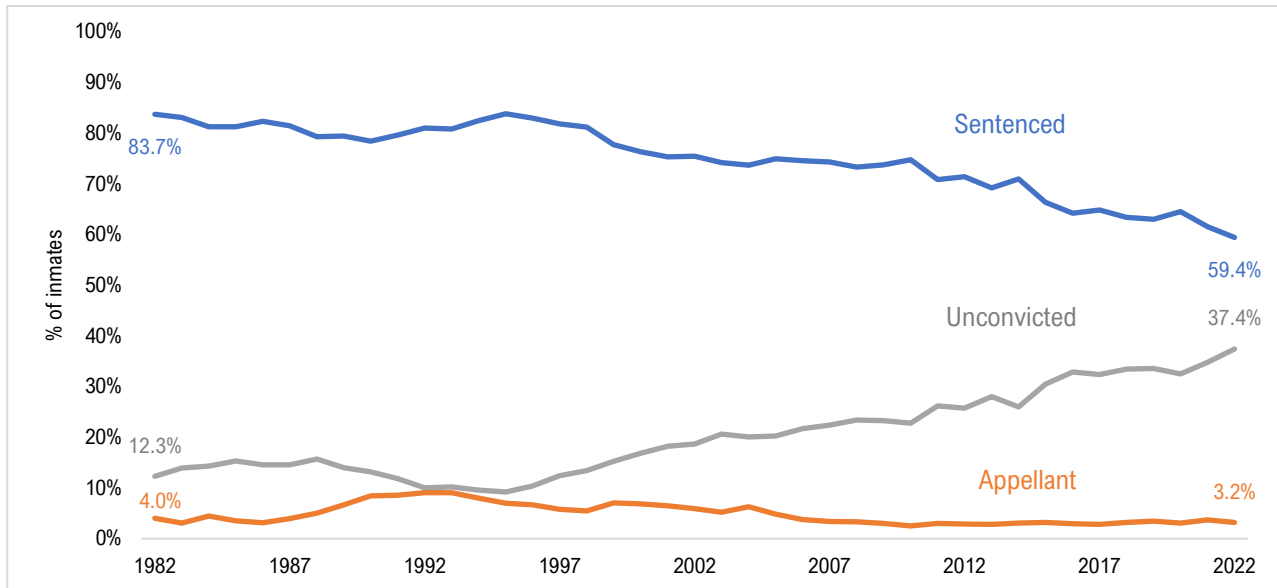

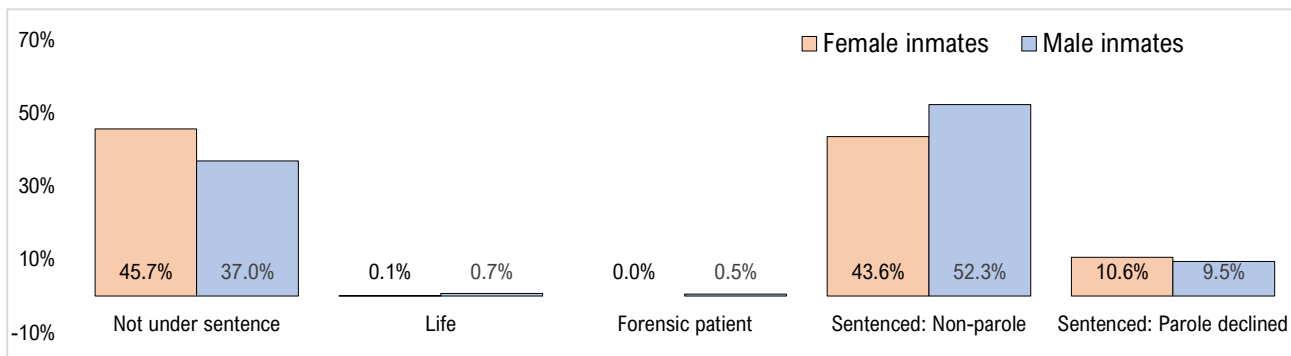

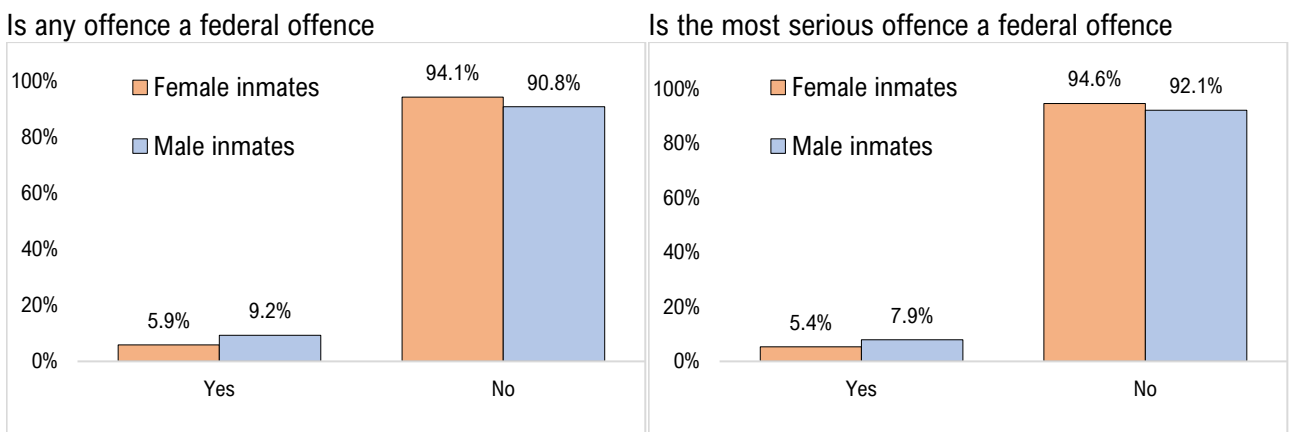
Legal status for inmates, 1982 to 2022



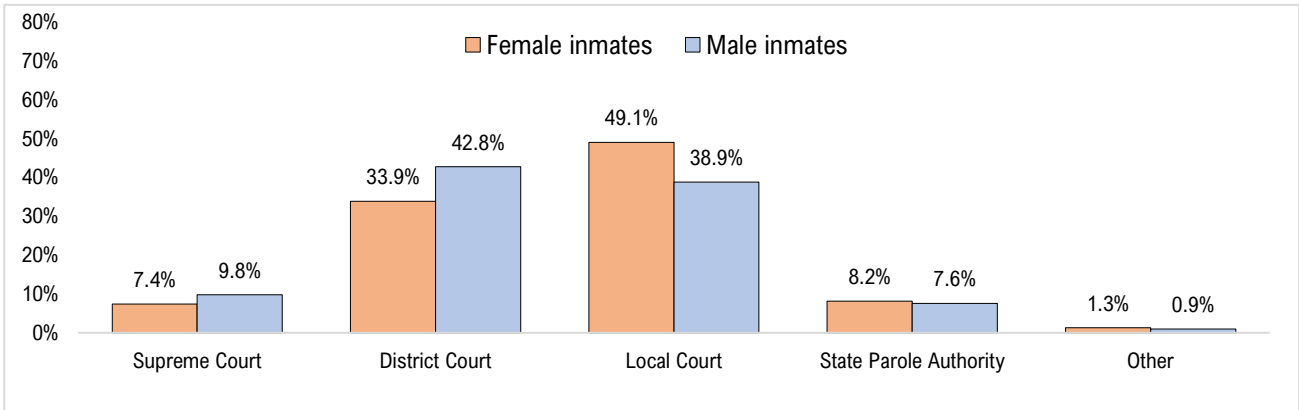
Sentence type for inmates, 2022



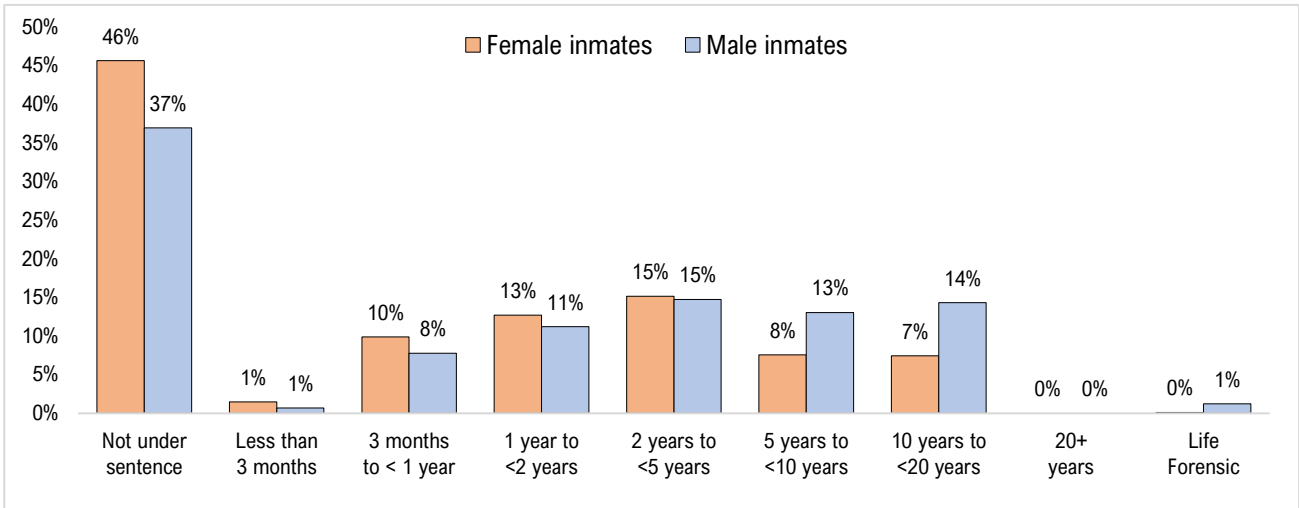
Federal offences for inmates, 2022



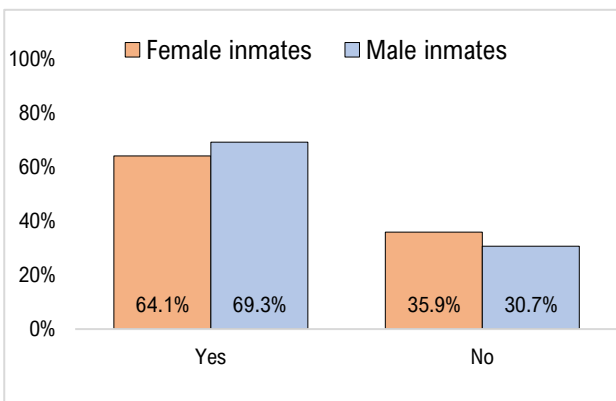
Level of court for most serious offence for inmates, 2022



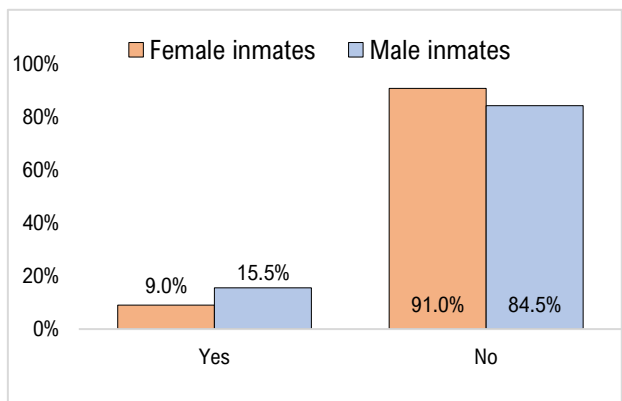
Length of aggregate sentence for inmates, 2022



Prior adult imprisonment, all inmates, 2022

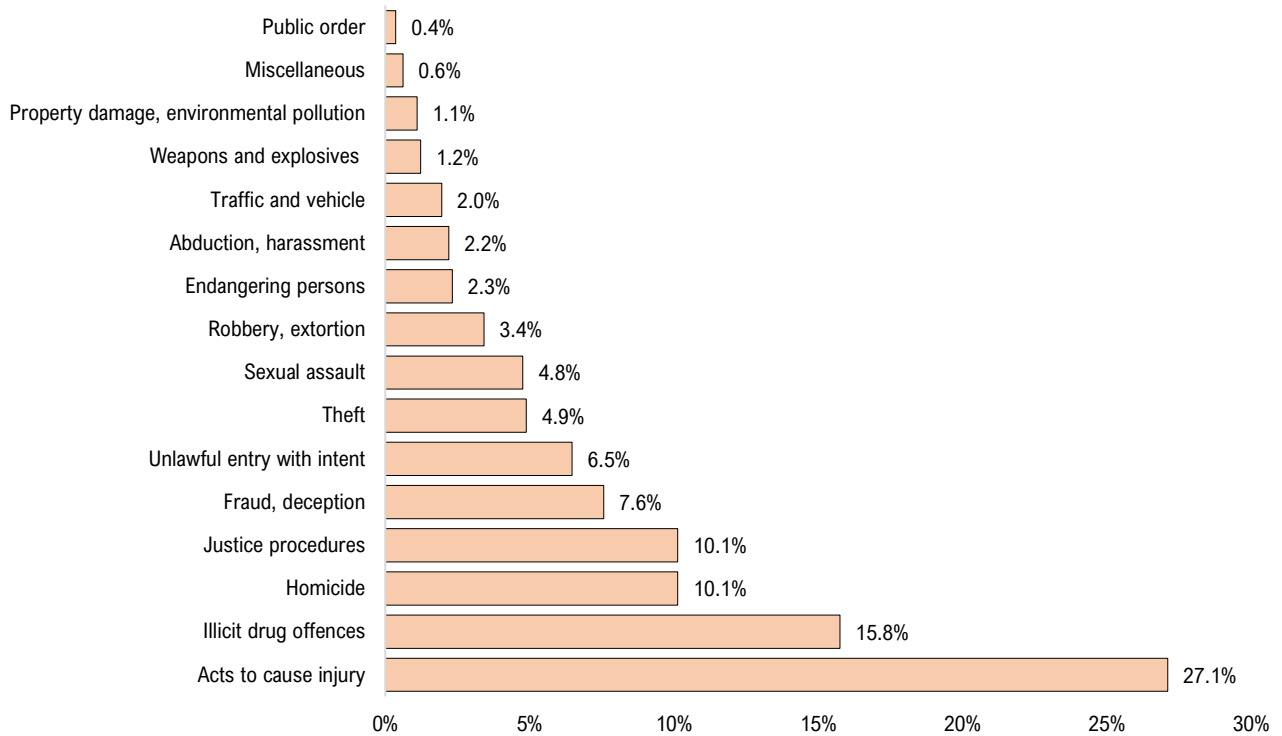


Breach of parole/escape, all inmates, 2022

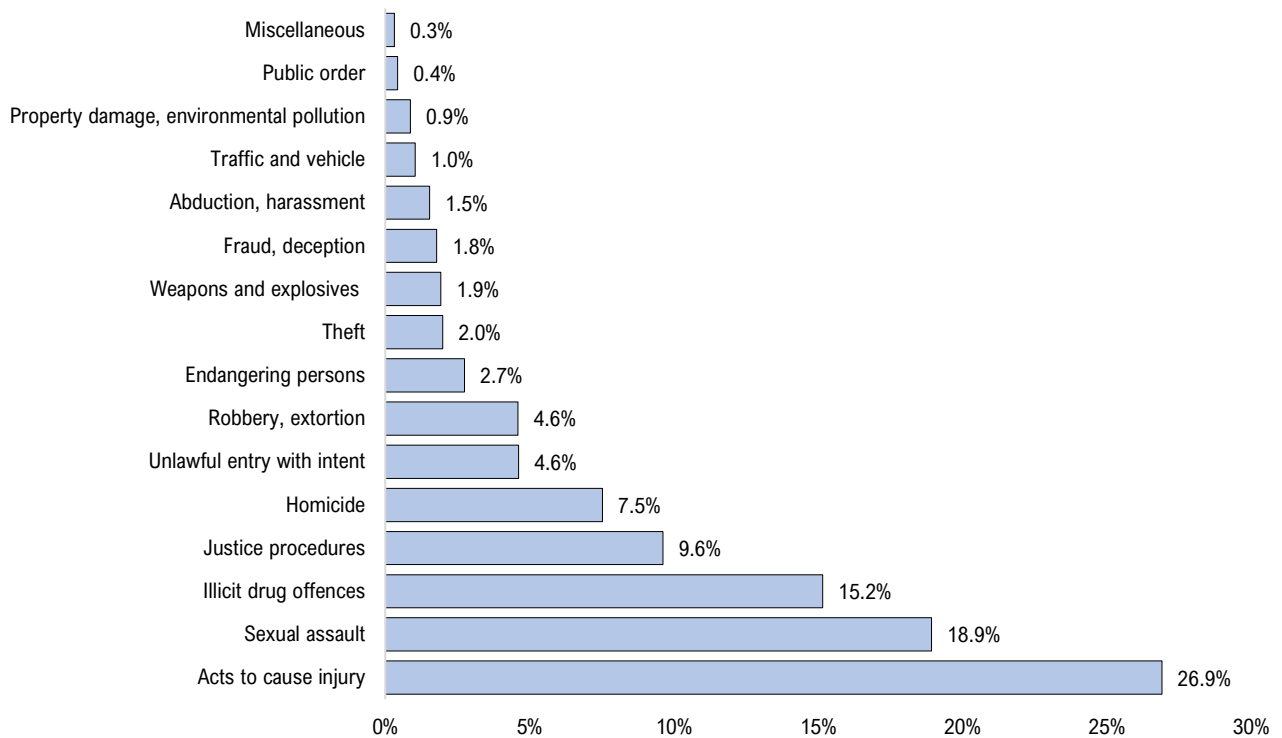

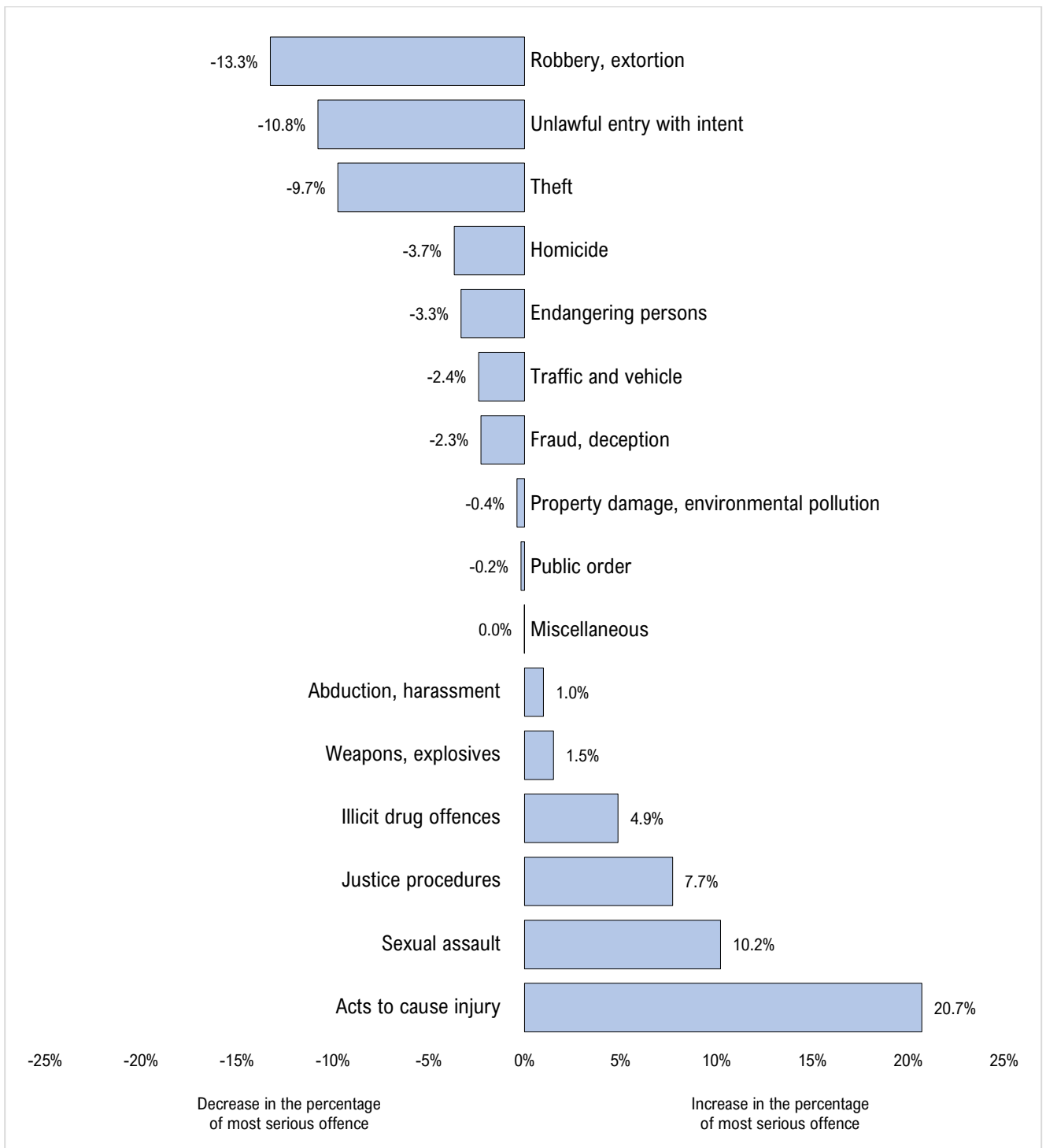

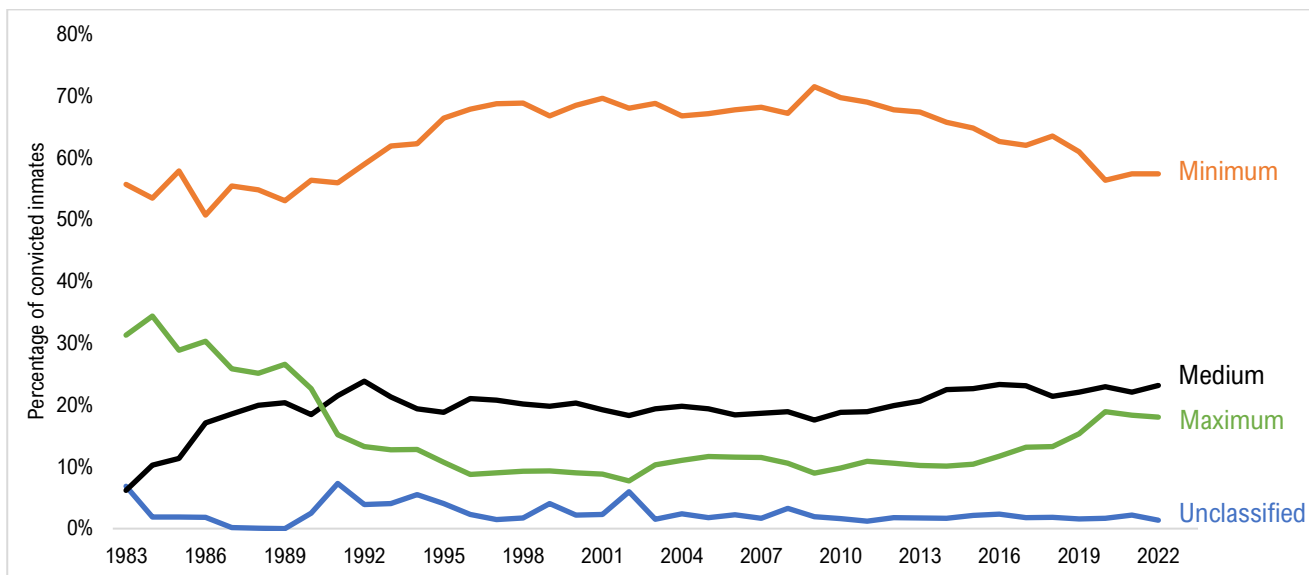
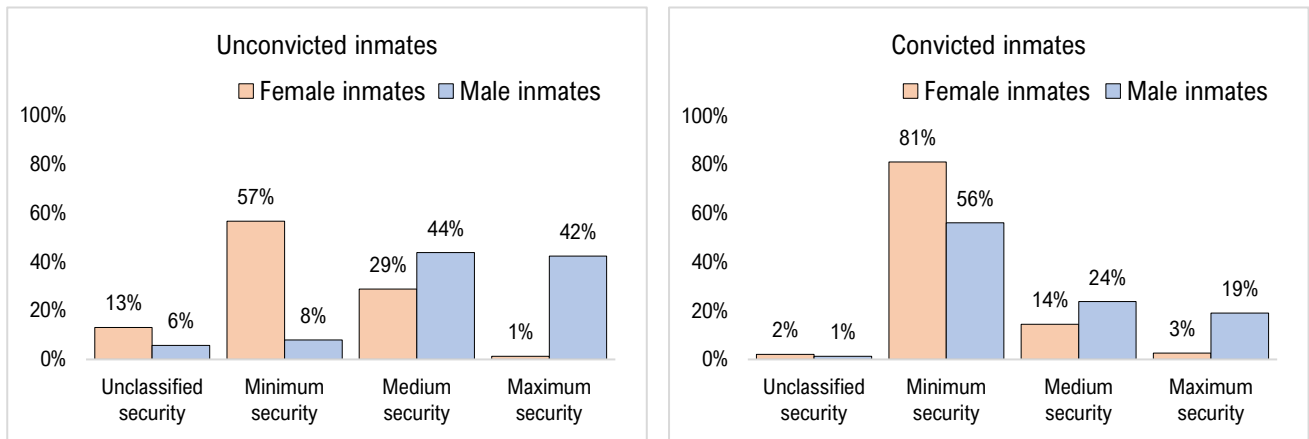


Change from 1982 to 2022 in the total percentage of most serious offence for all inmates

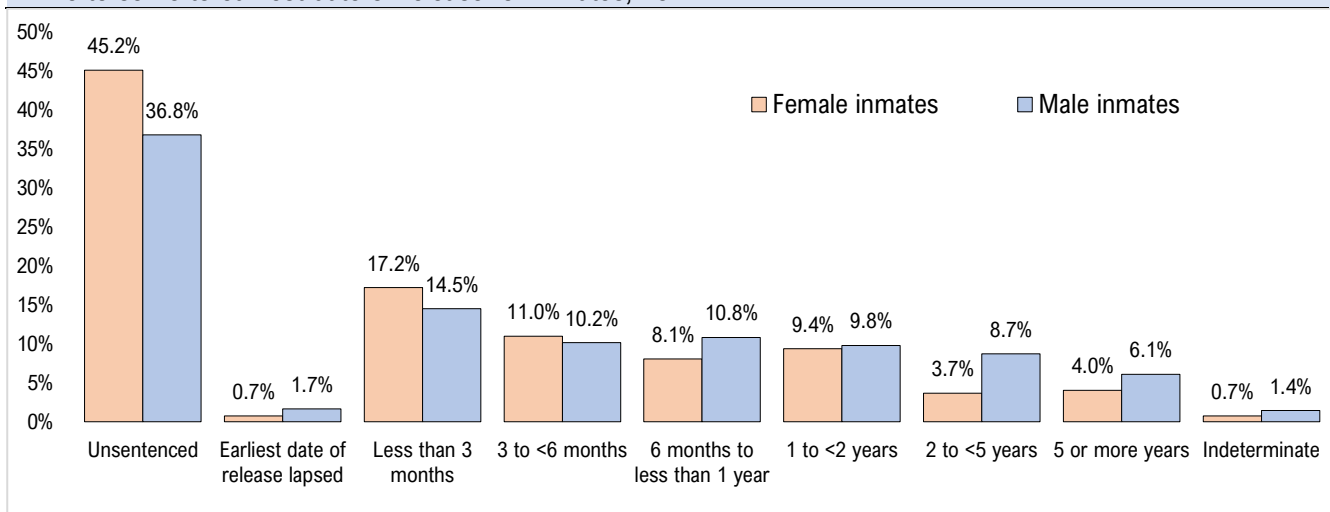

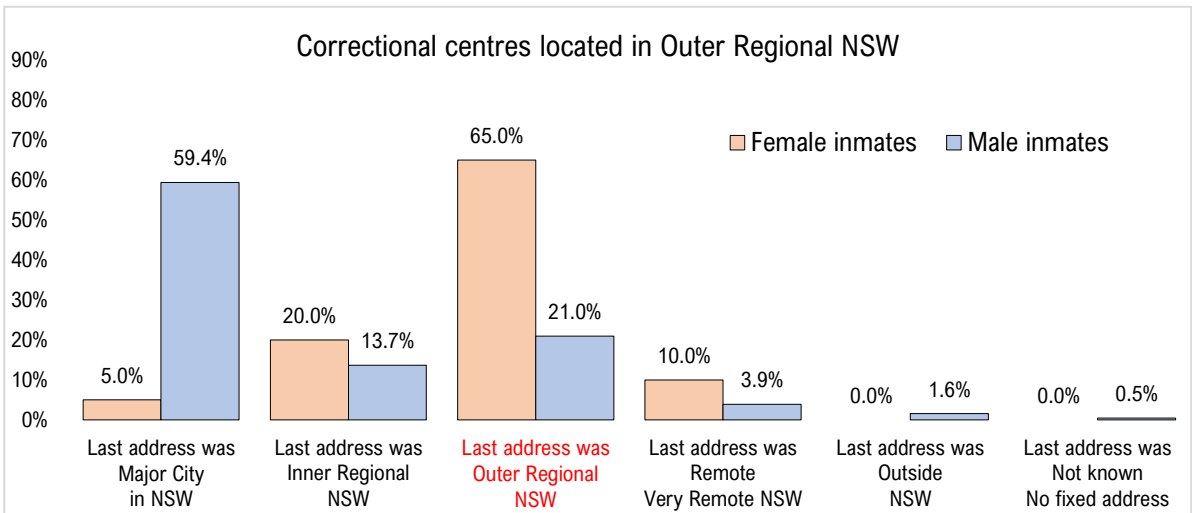
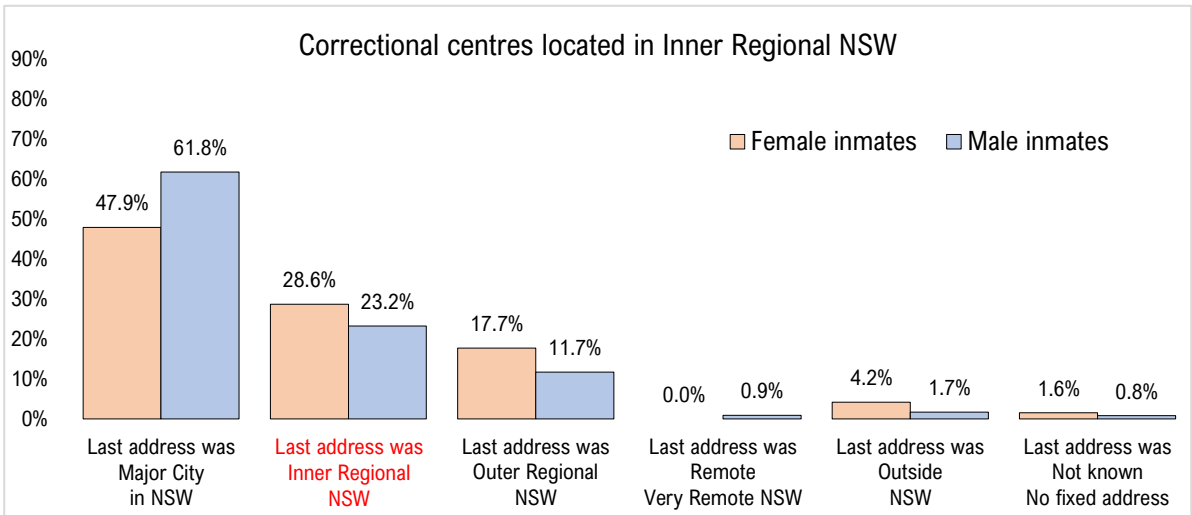
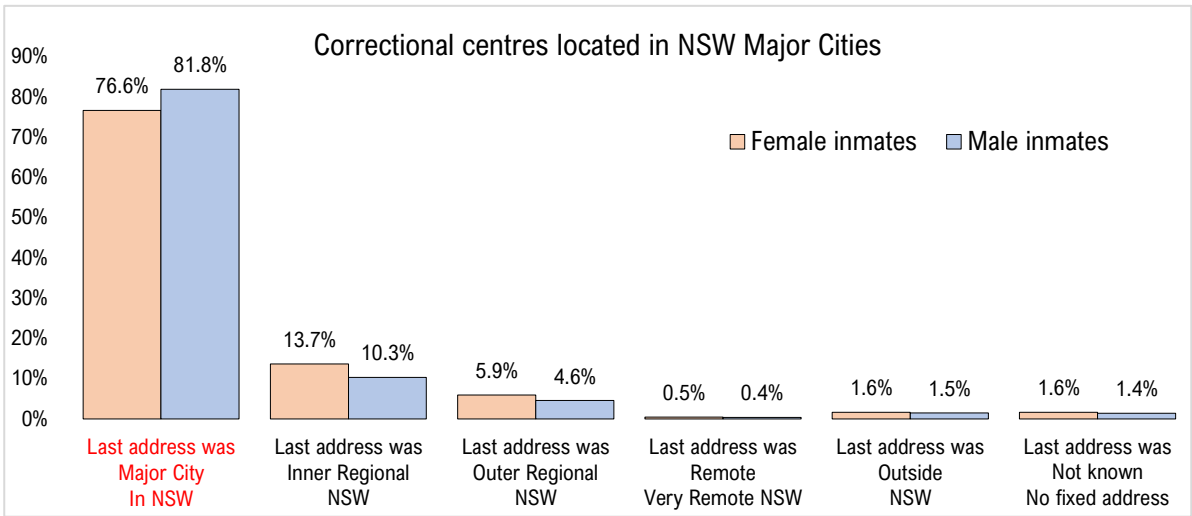
Security classification for inmates, 2022

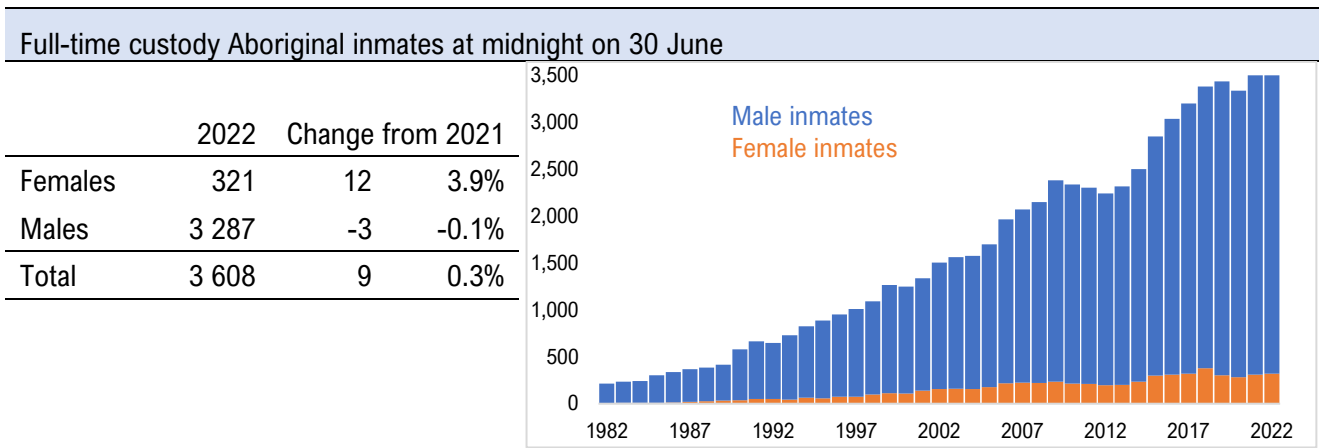

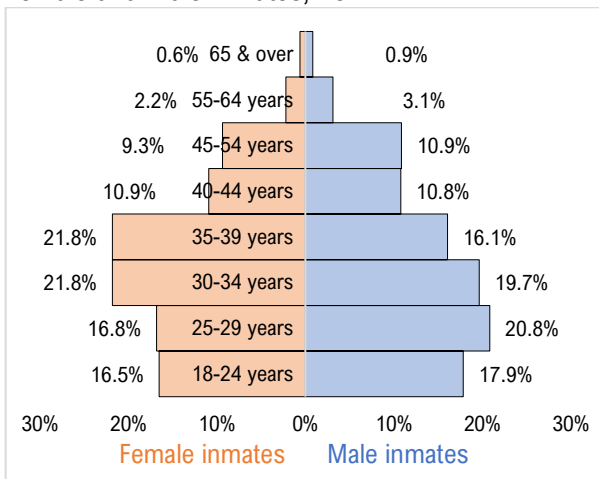

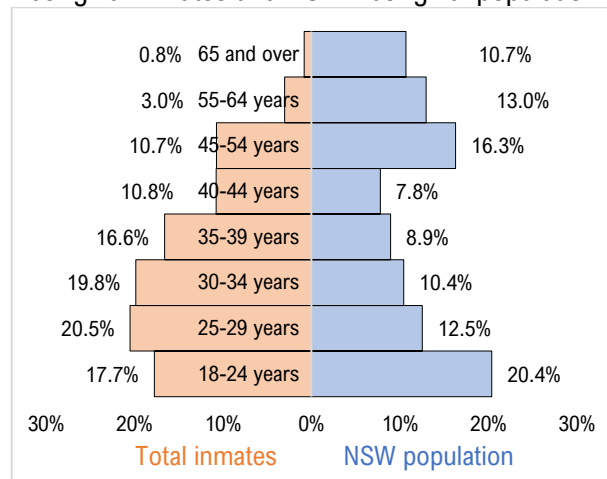
Age of Aboriginal inmates, 2022

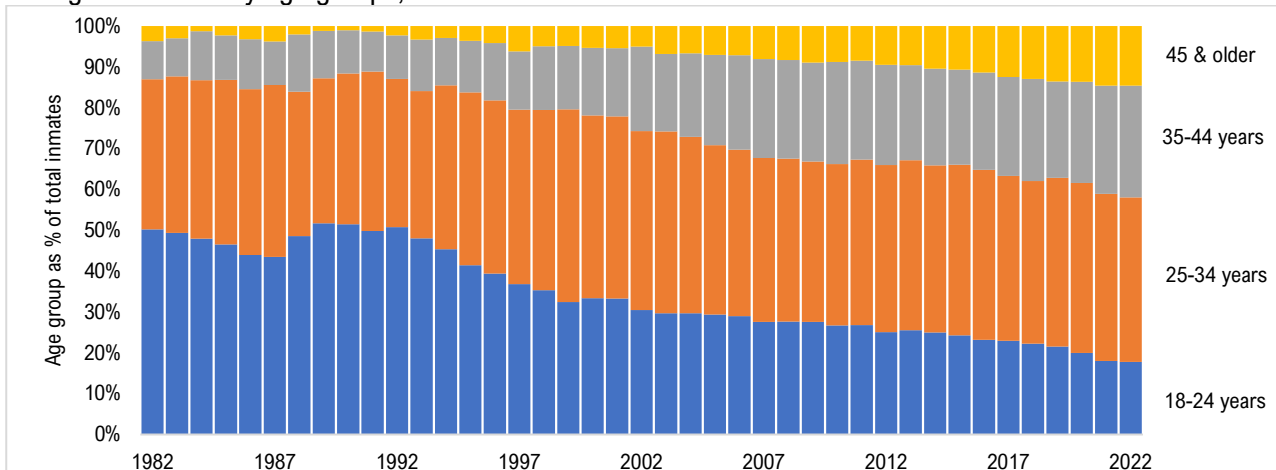
Female and male inmates, 2022



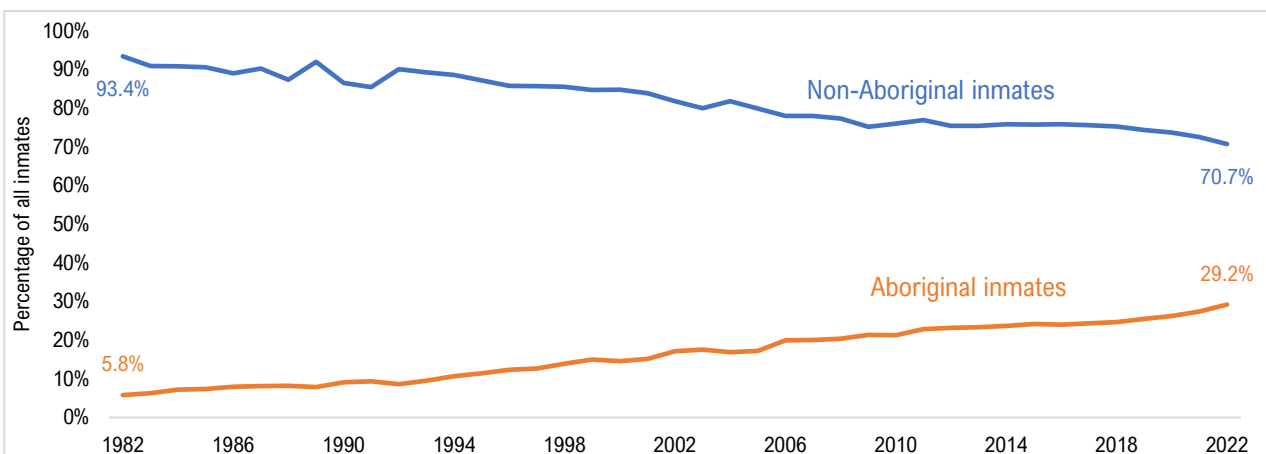
Aboriginal inmates and NSW Aboriginal population



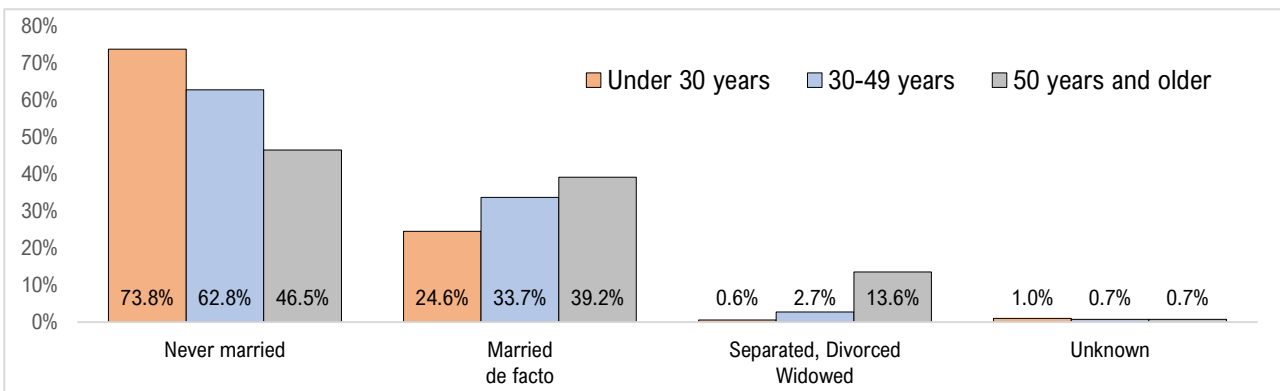
Aboriginal inmates by age groups, 1982 to 2022



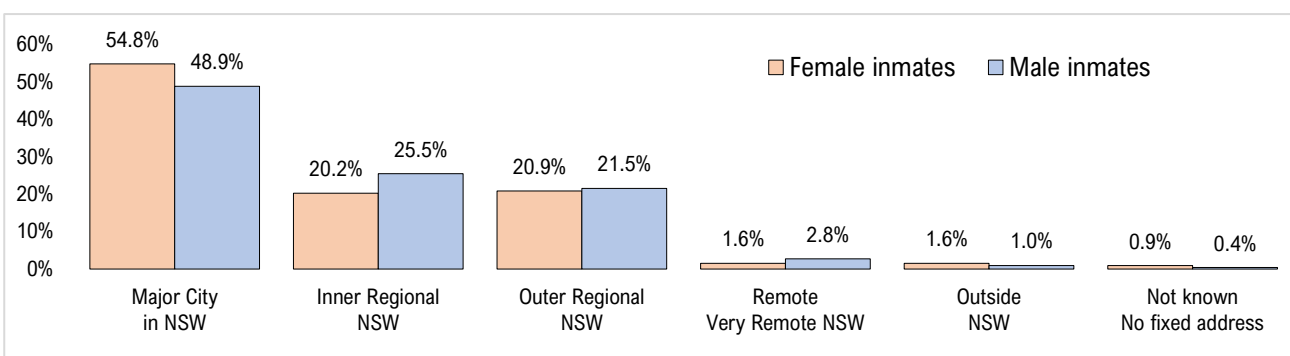

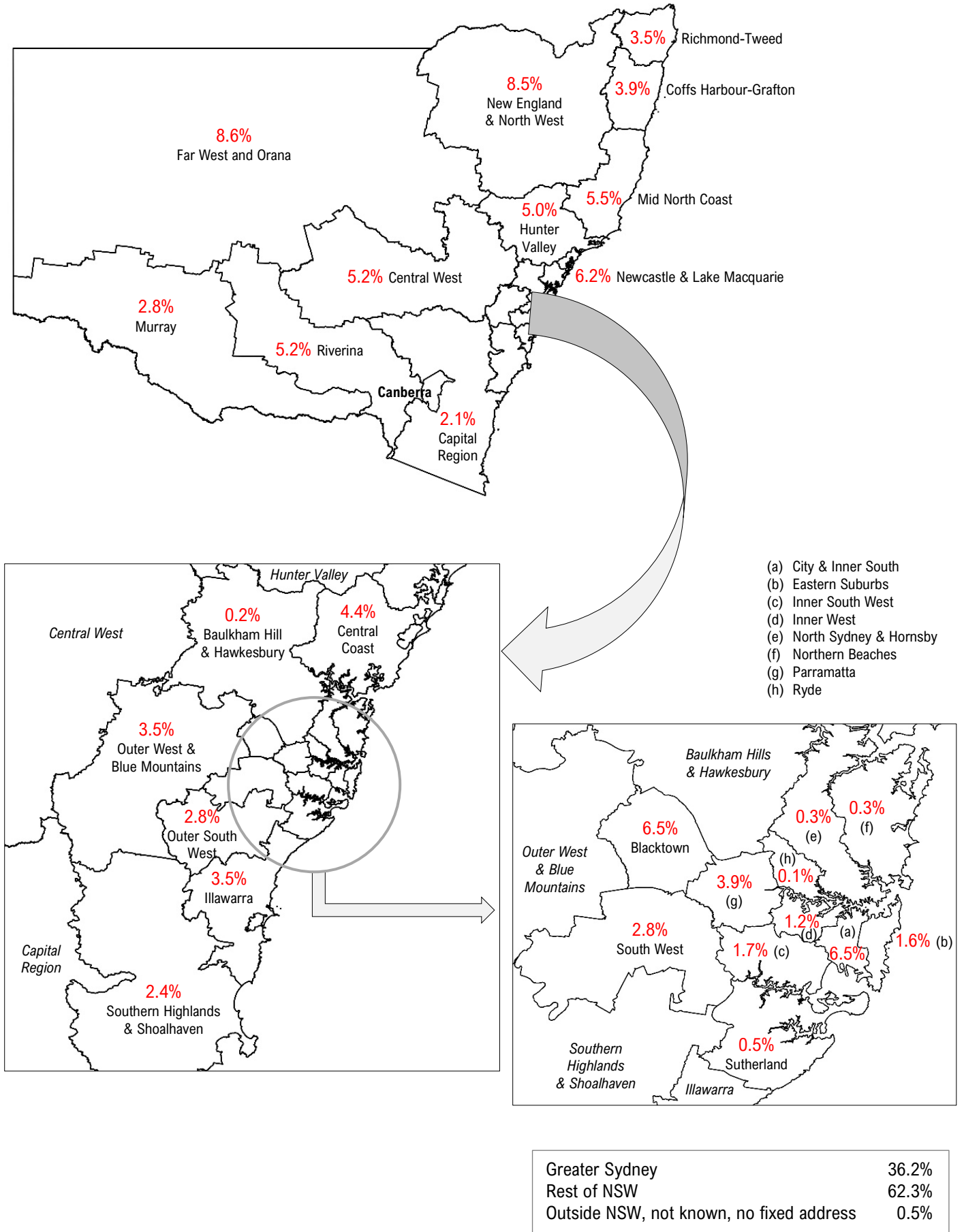
Marital status at reception for Aboriginal inmates, 2022



Last known address of Aboriginal inmates, 2022

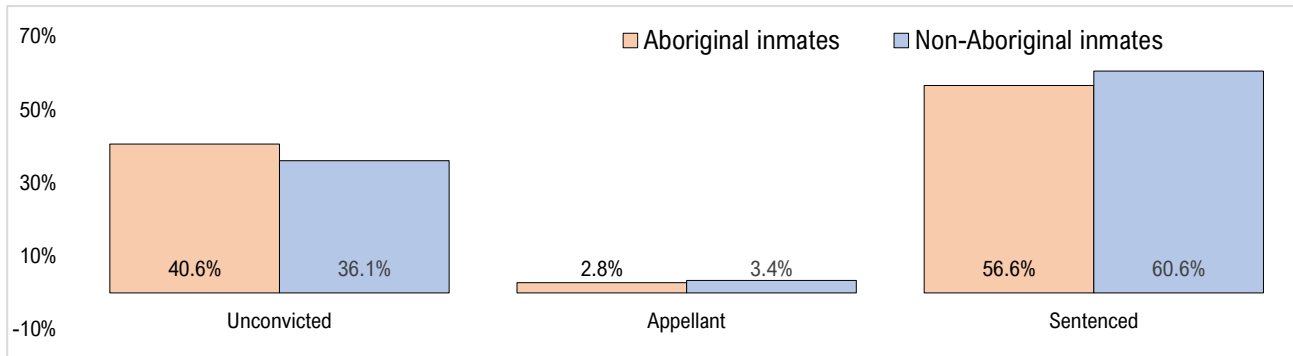


Last known address of Aboriginal inmates by ABS geography (Statistical Area Level 4), 2022

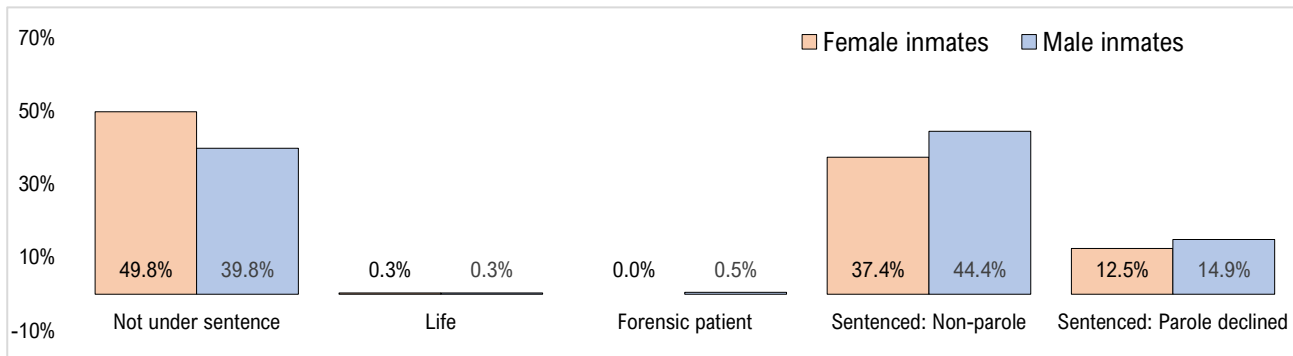

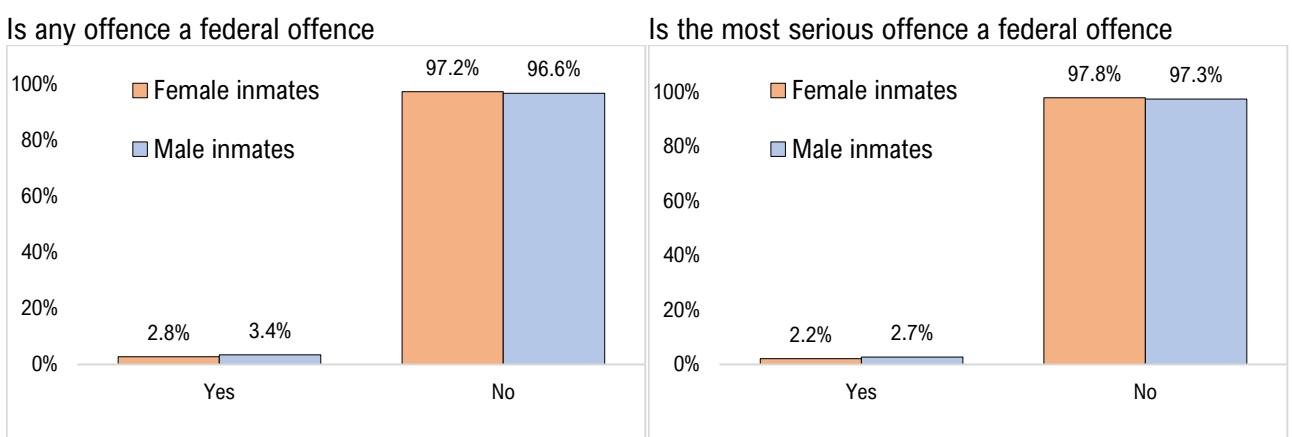
Legal status for Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal inmates, 2022



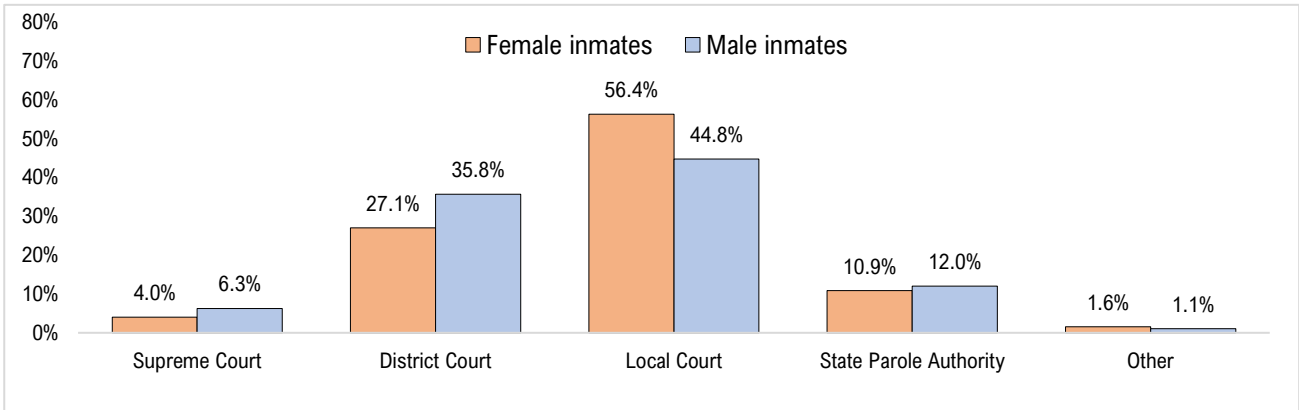
Sentence type for Aboriginal inmates, 2022



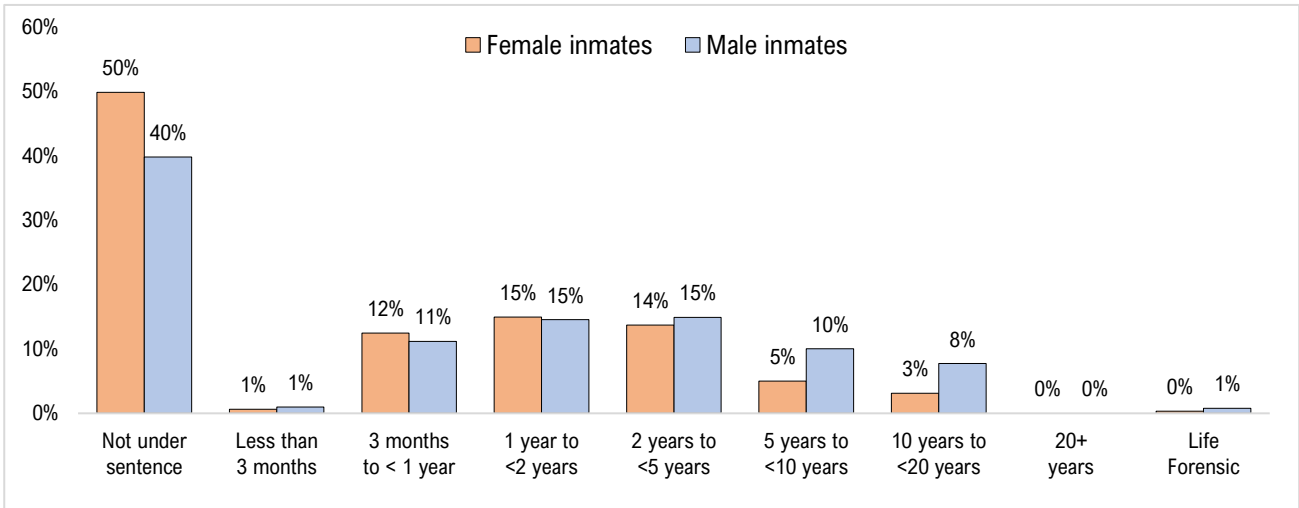
Federal offences for Aboriginal inmates, 2022



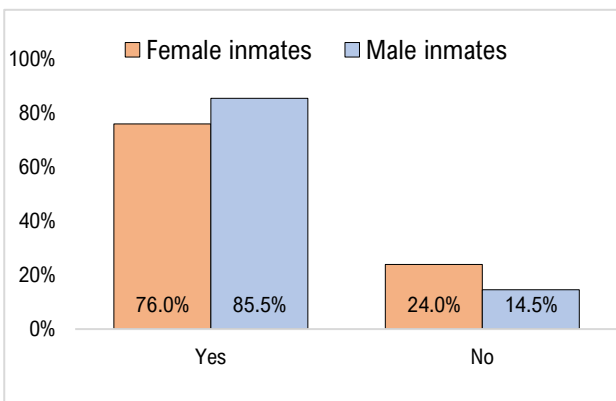
Level of court for most serious offence for Aboriginal inmates, 2022



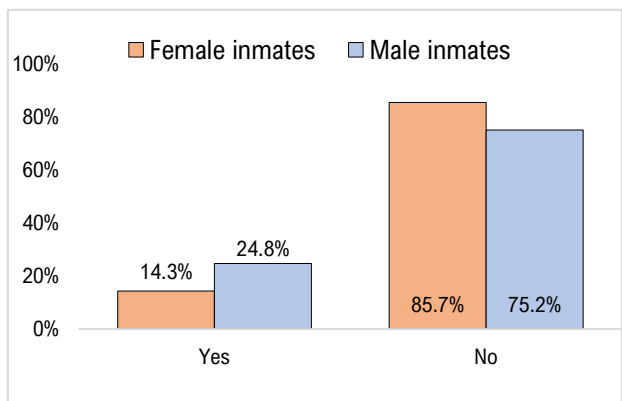
Length of aggregate sentence for Aboriginal inmates, 2022



Prior adult imprisonment, Aboriginal inmates, 2022

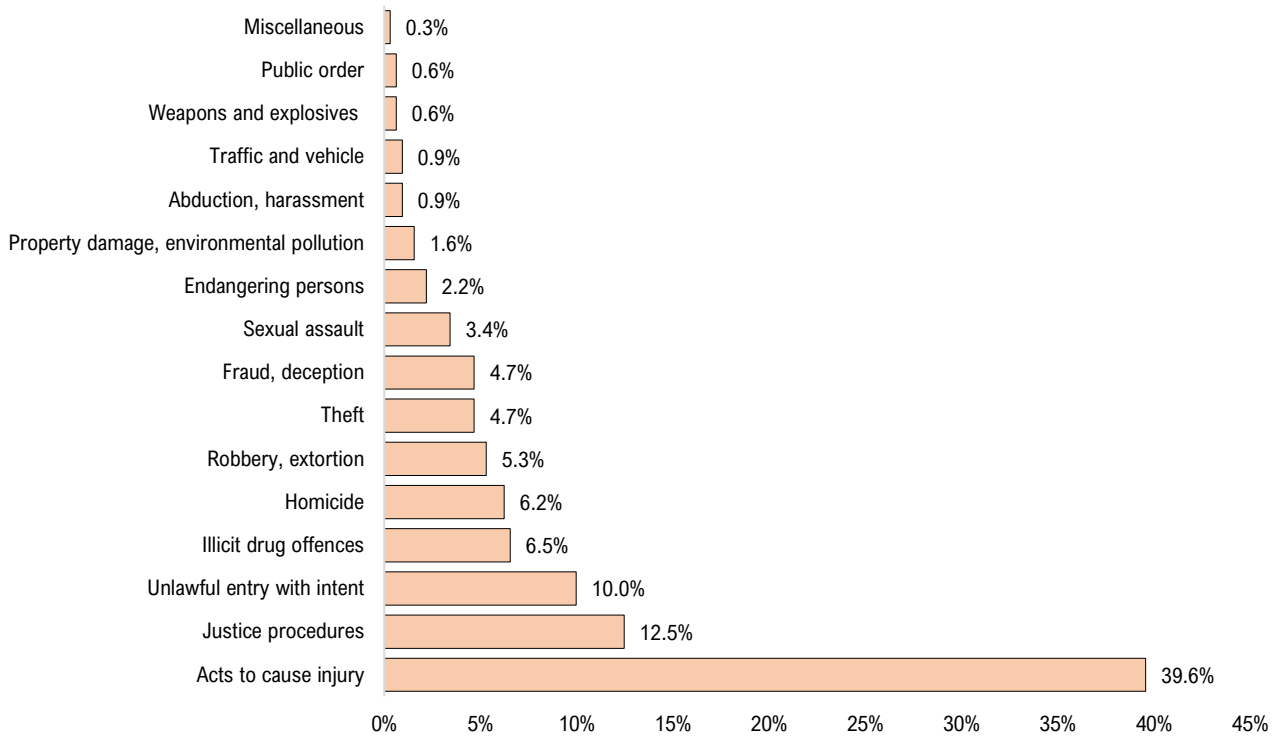

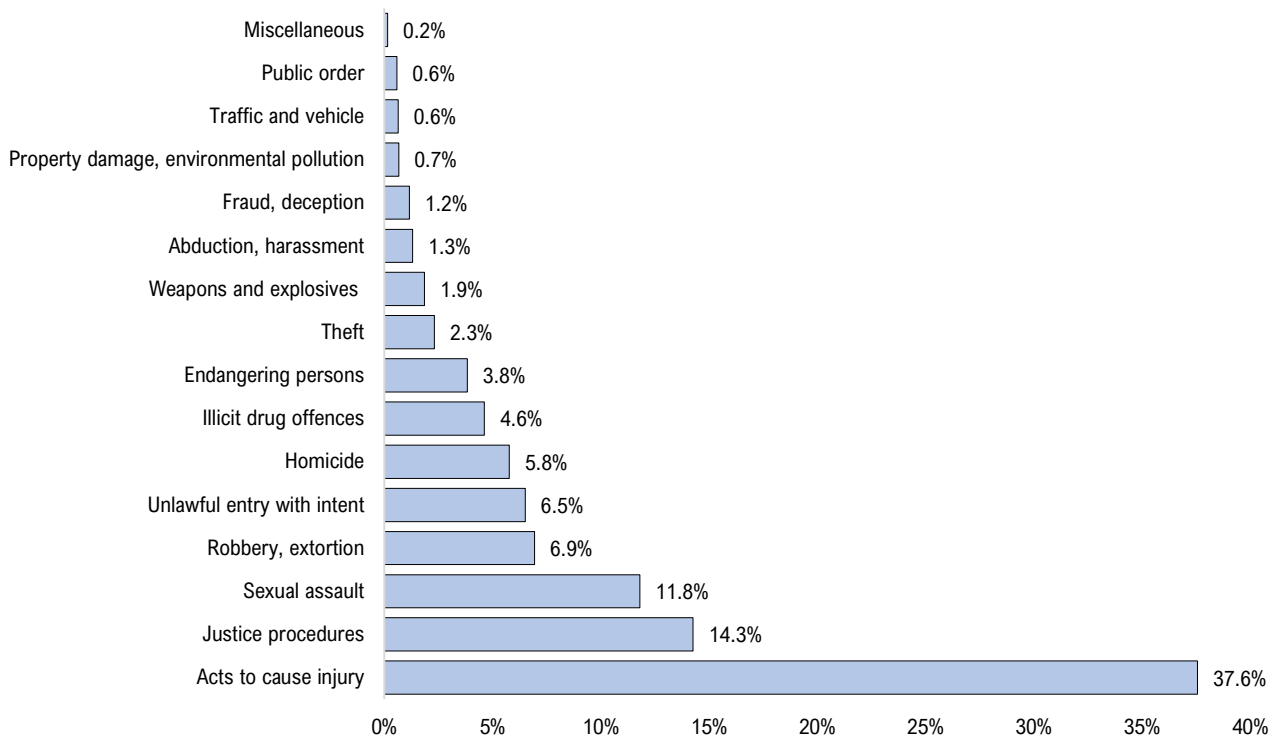

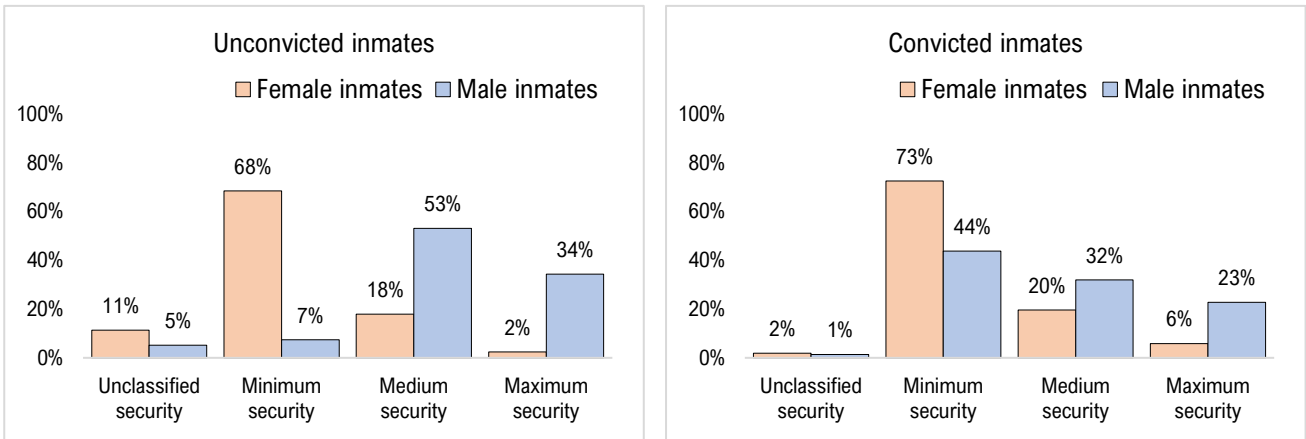

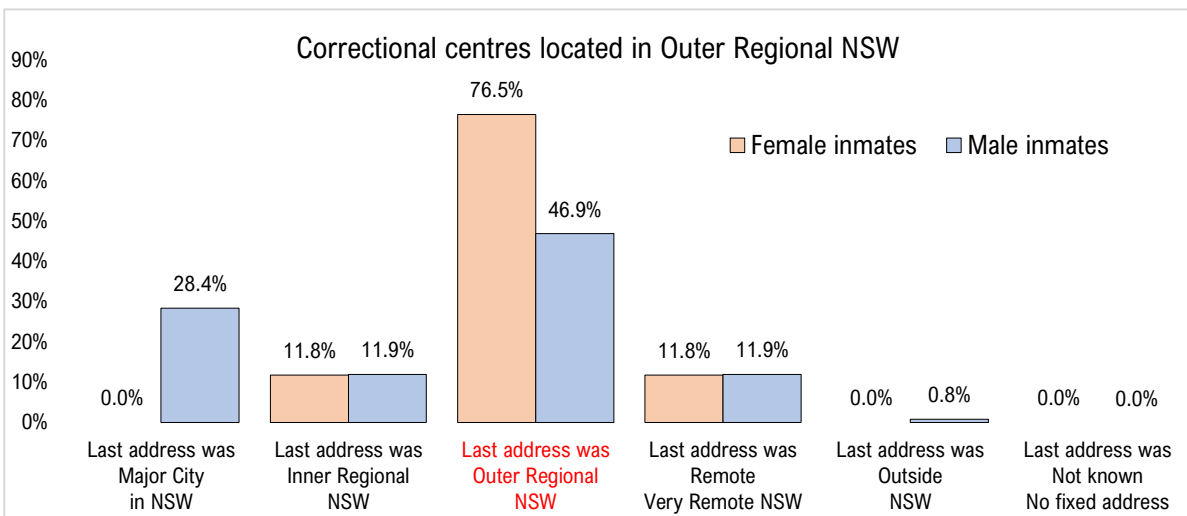
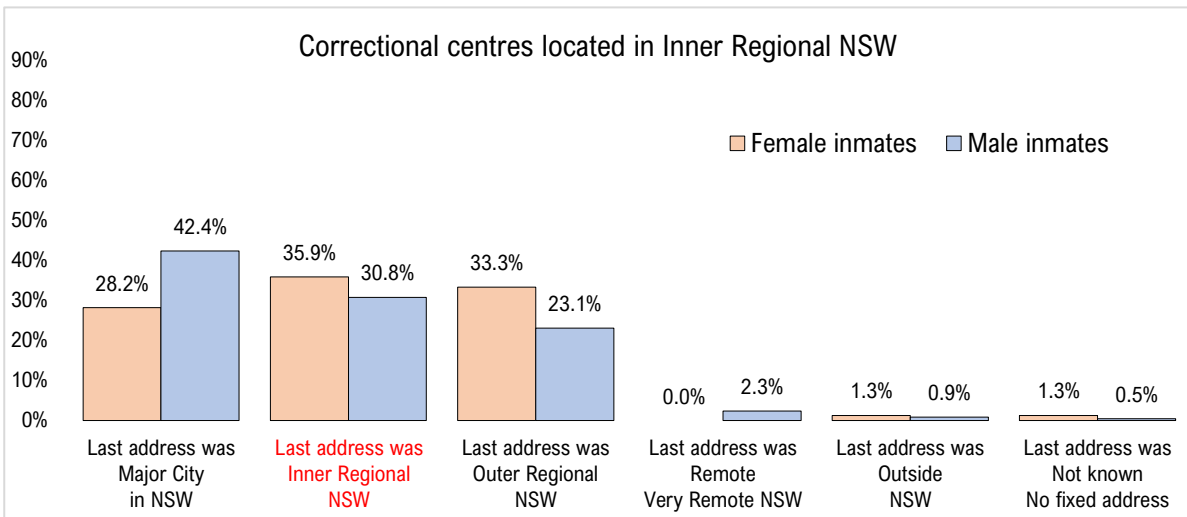
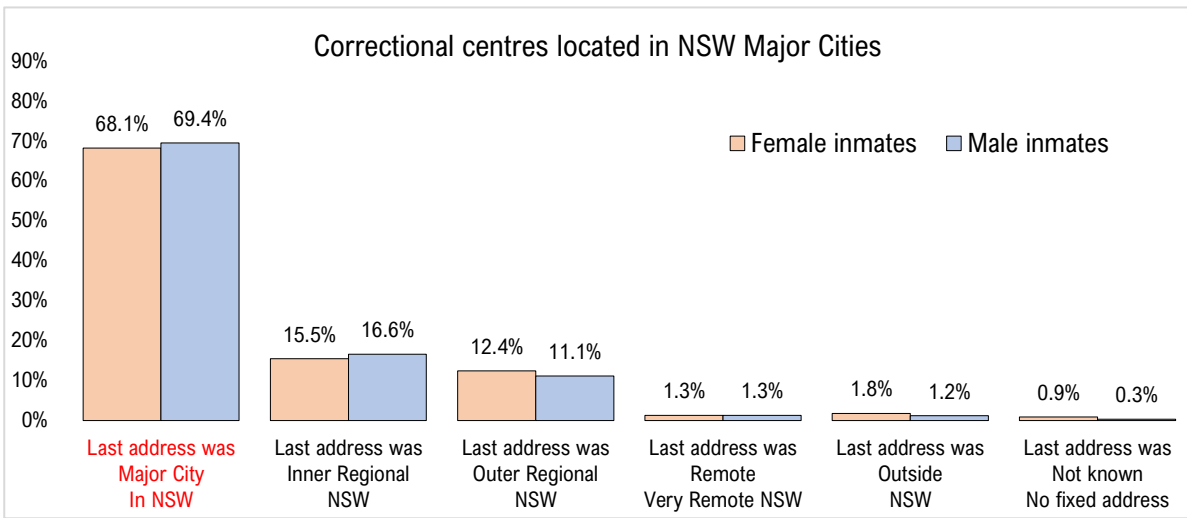
Security classification for Aboriginal inmates, 2022
