# **Transitional Supported Accommodation – TSA**

The Transitional Supported Accommodation (TSA) is a transitional support service provided under the Funded Partnership Initiative (FPI). TSA provides transitional post-release accommodation and casework support to medium-high and high risk offenders to reduce the risk of reoffending.

Service Providers will work collaboratively with Community Corrections and provide up to 12 weeks of support that is directly linked to an offender's case plan.

Additional support/outreach may be provided by the Service Provider beyond the TSA period.

### What are the eligibility criteria?

- ✓ Are 18 years and over
- ✓ Subject to supervision by CSNSW

  Community Corrections in the community
- ✓ Assessed as medium-high or high risk¹
- ✓ No other suitable accommodation options
- Meets any specific criteria for the individual TSA providers.
- On a case-by-case basis, exclusions may also be applied where there is an identified risk to the health or safety of the client /residents/staff/visitors at the residence.

Refer to section 6 of the <u>TSA - Protocol and</u> <u>Guiding Principles</u> for further details on exclusions, including sex offences, mental health and violent behaviours.

Note: Program participation is voluntary.

#### How can I refer an offender to this service?

- ✓ Complete the TSA referral form
- Contact the relevant Community Corrections office and speak with the Gatekeeper to discuss referral.

#### Referrals can be made by:

- ✓ Local Community Corrections Offices
- ✓ Parole units
- ✓ SAPOs if it is identified that an offender is at risk of homelessness upon release, the SAPO can discuss with the parole unit regarding suitability/referral.

## Who is a Gatekeeper?

The Gatekeeper is the person in the Community Corrections office who inputs referrals and manages the waitlist for the FPI service.
